Paid parking is available in the Wellington Parking Garage, parking validation is not available for students.



Clark #22 Bus service to Wellington Ave. and it is a short walk west to the hospital



Hospital Emergency Alert System

Plain Language Emergency Notification System

There are 4 plain language CATEGORIES that will serve as the CORE ANNOUNCEMENT for all emergency notifications for Advocate Aurora Health:

- Facility Alert- Examples: Fire Alarms, Electricity Disruption, Hazardous Spill, Decontamination, Evacuation, Incident Command, HIT/IS, etc.
- **Medical Alert** Examples: Patient Surge, Trauma (Adult/Pediatric), Medical Code Team (Adult/Pediatric), Rapid Response Team (Adult/Pediatric), Stroke Alert, Behavioral Health Response Team, STEMI, Help Response, Sepsis, etc.
- **Security Alert** Examples: Missing Person (Adult/Child/Infant), Suspicious Package, Security Assist, Perimeter Control/Lock Down, Active Threat, etc.
- Weather Alert- Examples: Severe Thunderstorm, Tornado, Snowstorm, Ice Storm, etc.

Following the Core Announcement, the type of emergency (in plain language) and location will be communicated via the overhead paging system.

Example: "Medical Alert—Rapid Response—7-Stone—Room 7202

To report an emergency at Illinois Masonic, use any hospital phone and call 61-6911



ID Badges

Students are expected to wear their school-provided picture identification badges at all times while on Advocate Illinois Masonic Medical Center property. On-site clinical group faculty will receive an Illinois Masonic ID badge from public safety prior to the beginning of their rotation. Please reach out to Elizabeth to obtain an ID. Badges should always be worn above the waist while on Advocate Illinois Masonic Medical Center property.

Illinois Masonic will not provide ID badges for pre-licensure or post-licensure students.
