

# Directions to Advocate Lutheran General Hospital

<u>Advocate Lutheran General Hospital</u> is located 15 miles northwest of downtown Chicago and four miles north of O'Hare International Airport.

**From the north,** take the Tri-State Tollway I-294 south. Exit at Golf Road and travel east on Golf Road to Potter Road. Turn right on Potter and travel south to Dempster Street. Turn left on Dempster and travel east to the hospital.

**From the south,** take the Tri-State Tollway I-294 north. Exit at Dempster Street east. Travel onehalf mile east on Dempster to the hospital. From the southwest, take I-88 or I-55 east to Tri-State I-294 north and follow above directions.

**From the east,** take the Edens Expressway I-94 north. Exit at Dempster Street west. Continue west on Dempster to the hospital.

**From the west,** take the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway I-90 east to the Tri-State Tollway I-294 north. Exit on Dempster Street east. Travel one-half mile east on Dempster to the hospital.




# Parking

Park in the North Surface Lot which is located north of Dempster. Turn north at the light on Luther Lane (located across the street from the hospital).

## Please do not park:

- In Jewel/Portillo's parking lot you will be towed
- In the visitor garage which is reserved for our guests
- Behind the hospital in the Yacktman Pavilion you will be ticketed by the Park Ridge Police Department

# **Professional Appearance**

## General

• Students are required to present with a clean, neat and well-groomed appearance

## Uniforms

- Clothing should be clean and cover the body appropriately including the midriff, back, chest, stomach, and undergarments.
- General clinical areas
  - School Uniform
- Specialty areas (i.e., OR, PACU, POCU, L&D, ASC, NICU)
  - Wear hospital issued scrubs

## Badges

- ID badges will be worn above the waist.
- Students will wear their **school-provided picture identification** while on Advocate property.
- On-site clinical faculty will obtain an **Advocate ID badge** from public safety prior to the beginning of their rotation.

## Footwear

- Feet should be covered at all times.
- Sandals and flip flops are not permitted.

## Hair:

- Hair should be clean and adhere to departmental guidelines.
- Facial hair should be clean and, unless a religious accommodation has been provided, trimmed.

## Other

- Jewelry should be professional and not interfere with safety or performing assigned functions
- Maintain good personal hygiene such that body odor, smoke or other odors such as cologne or perfume are not detectable.
- Tattoos containing inappropriate or offensive messages or images (such as profanity, sexual images, depictions of violence, etc.) must not be visible.
- Artificial fingernails or extenders are not permitted, and natural nail tips should be less than ¼ inch long.

**	<b>Weather</b> – Severe thunderstorm, Tornado, Snowstorm & Ice Storm

- Facility Alert, Fire Alarm, 10<sup>th</sup> floor, Cafeteria
