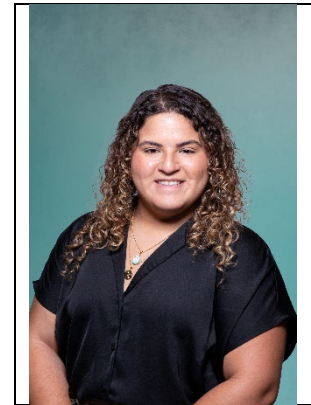


Integrated Clinical Practice Chiropractic Residency Resident Biographies, 2024-2025

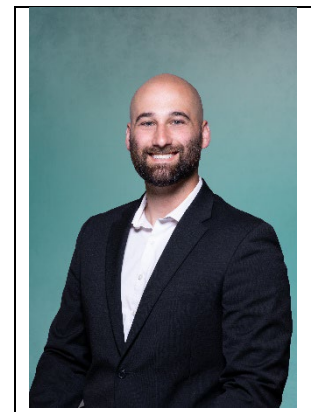
